


KNOW YOUR NYC RESTROOM RIGHTS

The New York City Commission on Human Rights says that these acts may be **gender identity discrimination**:

Stopping you from using a restroom or other sex-segregated facility that matches your gender identity and gender expression.

Asking you to provide ID to prove your gender in order to use a restroom or other sex-segregated facility.

These rules are not well known. Show this card if you have problems using a restroom or other sex-segregated facility because of your gender identity or expression.
